We want to inform you that the HCM result of your cat has been registered in the health database of PawPeds by one of our volunteers. The result will be published in the pedigree database within the next hours or days (depending on the breed).

Hidden result for 60 days

Please be aware that your result is hidden for the first 60 days after the cat is screened. When the result is registered and published It will show the text “Result registered but not public yet” for the first 60 days after the examination date. This period is to protect the owner in case of a bad result. It will provide the owner the opportunity to digest the result, inform others and decide what to do with it, before it is made public.

Help in case your cat's result isn't visible

If your cat's result isn't visible yet in a few days, one of these things might be the reason:

- This can happen when your cat's pedigree isn't registered yet in the pedigree database of your breed. You can check this by searching for your cat in the pedigree database. We kindly ask all to send in the pedigree/registration slip

for registration in the pedigree database a few weeks BEFORE having your cat screened on HCM. This allows the registration process to go faster, with less work for volunteers and less risks of mistakes. You can send in your cat's pedigree easily through our ticket system <https://www.pawpeds.com/cms/index.php/en/databases/maintainers>.

- It could also be that the information (especially the pedigree name) about your cat doesn't match how the cat is registered in the pedigree database, so our volunteers could not identify your cat and link the HCM result to the correct cat in the pedigree database. Sometimes the information on the form is handwritten and very hard to read. If this is the case, then next time we kindly ask you to fill in the HCM form on your computer and print and sign the form and bring to your appointment. If your cat is registered in the pedigree databases, and you suspect that this is the issue, please contact hcm@pawpeds.com to have it manually corrected.
- Some breeds do not have an active HCM health programme, so those results will not be published in the pedigree database. For those breeds the results can be seen by downloading the health file for that breed from <https://www.pawpeds.com/cms/index.php/en/health-programmes/download>. On <https://www.pawpeds.com/cms/index.php/en/health-programmes/info> you can check which breeds have an active HCM health programme.

If all seems right and your cat's result is still not visible, then you can contact hcm@pawpeds.com to have the issue investigated. When you do, please mention the pedigree name of your cat, the veterinarian's name and the examination date.
